Vote Safely by Mail in the June 23rd Primary Election



All registered voters are eligible to receive an absentee ballot and asked to vote by mail, if possible.



May 22 - June 15

June 23

Deadline to mail your absentee ballot

- ★ postage is included with each ballot
- ★ all mailed ballots must be postmarked June 23rd

- **June 8 - June 22** County Clerk offices are open for in-person voting by appointment.
